

LIGHTING THE NEIGHBORHOOD Many thanks to everyone who is lighting up neighborhood!!

Continue to help light up our neighborhood by keeping your outside garage (not porch) lights turned on from dusk until dawn. If you are not doing this now, please join us. It is amazing how much more this "lights up our streets", making a safer environment for all. If you notice a really dark area on your street ask your neighbor to join in lighting up the area or contact me.

Continue to lock the vehicles in your driveway, even though no more burglaries have been reported. It's just a good habit.

You can report problems by calling the Sheriff's office at 800-706-2488 anonymously. If you have reported suspicious activity before, do it again. If reporting stops, it will be assumed the problem has been solved. I was told by a Local Sheriff's deputy this is important and may be the reason some of our biggest concerns have not been eliminated.


