Christmas/Holiday Open House Tuesday, December 5th



DEED RESTRICTIONS-Things to Remember

Dogs must be on a leash when not behind a fence. Dogs cannot be loose in the Subdivision. This is Pasco County ordinance too.

Be a good "pack leader" for your pet, and keep him safe behind a fence or on a leash when he is not fenced. Even playing, a child or elderly person can be knocked down as well as scared by your pet.

When you walk your dog/dogs, be sure to pick up their waste. It is the responsible thing to do as a pet owner and neighbor. Also, leaving waste on the ground, street, or walk, adds to the pollution of our water.

RECIPES

I'm assuming the tradition of eating blackeyed peas and cabbage or greens on New Year's Day is from the Deep South, as I only learned of it after moving to South Louisiana. The food is supposed to represent good luck and money in the new year. If you don't like cooked cabbage, this can be a nice alternative.

Coleslaw with raisins, dill, and honeyroasted peanuts

1/2 cup mayonnaise

- 2 teaspoons distilled white or apple Cider vinegar
- 1 teaspoon sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper
- 4 cups shredded green cabbage (1/2 medium head)
- 1 cup grated carrot (1 large)
- 1/4 cup finely chopped Vidalia onion
- 2 Tablespoons chopped dill
- 1/4 cup raisins
- 1/4 cup chopped honey-roasted peanuts
- 1. In a small bowl, whisk together the mayo, Vinegar, sugar, salt and black pepper.
- 2. In a large salad bowl, combine the cabbage, carrot, onion, dill, and raisins. Stir in the dressing and toss well to combine. Let the slaw stand for 10 minutes for the flavors to develop before sprinkling with peanuts to serve.


**Rich's cousin Susan gave me this recipe. She always added rice noodles to the recipe, and I really liked the addition.

















