

New Recycling Rules:

October 1, 2015, Pasco County will change its Recycling program. Basically, they will no longer allow use of the "blue bags".

The new guidelines will be published in the October Newsletter .

Town Hall Meeting—More Info

In a effort to keep more homeowners in their homes and to encourage new home buyers, Pasco County is offering a Homeownership Assistance Program, the Pasco Opportunity Program (POP), and a Tax Payment Program.

Homeownership Assistance Program provides assistance toward the purchase of any home in Pasco County, except mobile and manufactured homes. Townhomes and condos are eligible in addition to single family homes.

The maximum purchase price cannot exceed \$240.000.00. Depending on your income level, and how much you can put down, the Assistance amount is \$5000 or \$10,000. Call 727-834-3445 the Pasco County Community Development in New Port Richey for additional information.

Pasco Opportunity Program (POP) is a Partnership between Pasco County and several non-profit agencies, The agencies buy homes, have them repaired, made energy efficient, and make them available for sale. You may qualify for down payment assistance of up to \$30,000.00 depending on your income level. To inquire about purchase of one of these homes, call 727-834-3445 for more information.

Tax Payment Program has been created to help seniors (62 and over) and homeowners who are disabled pay for Property Taxes. The goal of the program is to keep homeowners in their homes. Any type of home is eligible for the program including Condos and town homes. Only the tax on the property of a mobile home is eligible. The home value cannot exceed \$160,000.00, according to the Pasco County Property Appraiser. The most available to you is \$5,000.00. Please call 727-834-3445 for additional information.

The following items **will not** be picked up by Progressive Waste regular garbage pickup:

- Amount set out over 6 item-limit
- Non-regulation container size.
 Maximum size is 33 gallon or
 50 pounds. All cans over 33 gallon must be bagged.
- Brush longer than 4 feet, OR not bundled and tied.
- Trash not in bags or cans.
- **Hazardous materials** in trash or garbage. Most common materials: pesticides, paint, pool chemicals.
- Large bulk items such as mattresses

Help, Help! Please bring one (or many) of your favorite recipes to the meeting onTuesday, email to me (dkmarx@gmail.com), or drop off at my home.


